

NOBU'S NEXT MOVE

In a way, Robert De Niro and Nobu Matsuhisa have worked Las Vegas before, both appearing in the 1995 Sin City classic *Casino*. Now the actor and the chef, who are longtime business partners, have hit the Strip for real, opening the first Nobu Hotel, a 181-room property anchored by the largest Nobu eatery yet, all inside Caesars Palace. The venture is the start of a series of hotels planned around the world. AD100 architect/designer David Rockwell (pictured above left, with Matsuhisa and De Niro) created the subtly glamorous interiors, which incorporate natural materials and Japanese motifs such as paper lanterns and cherry blossom–print wall coverings. At the restaurant, the tables to book are the four enclosed in woven-abaca pods.
